✓ Use this checklist to keep track of your college application tasks, deadlines, and required materials.

🔎 1. Research & Planning (January – August, Junior Year to Early Senior Year)

□ Make a list of potential colleges

P Don't forget to check the list of <u>Colleges of Distinction</u> that fit your wish list—each one is recognized for outstanding student engagement, great teaching, and successful outcomes!

Research application deadlines (Early Action, Early Decision, Regular)

ho Some colleges offer priority application deadlines with added scholarship opportunities—

□ Visit college websites for admission requirements

 \Box Attend college fairs and campus tours

 \Box Create a calendar with important deadlines

2. Standardized Tests (March – October, Junior Year to Senior Year)

□ Register for SAT/ACT (if required)

□ Prepare for SAT/ACT using practice tests

f Some colleges are **test-optional**—make sure to check if you need to submit scores!

□ Send test scores to colleges through College Board/ACT

📄 3. Application Materials (August – December, Senior Year)

 \Box Create an account on Common App or Coalition App

 \Box Fill out the application form

- \Box Write and edit your personal statement/essay
- □ Prepare supplemental essays (if required)
- Request official high school transcripts
- \Box List extracurricular activities and achievements

4. Letters of Recommendation (August – October, Senior Year)

 \Box Ask teachers/counselors for letters of recommendation

- \Box Provide recommenders with necessary information (resume, deadlines)
- \Box Follow up and ensure letters are submitted on time



🝈 5. Financial Aid & Scholarships (October – March, Senior Year)

Complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) (Opens October 1st) Complete the CSS Profile (if required by colleges)

\Box Search and apply for scholarships

P Many Colleges of Distinction offer merit-based scholarships! Look at their financial aid pages for exclusive awards.

□ Review and compare financial aid offers from colleges (January – April, Senior Year)

📫 6. Submitting Applications (September – January, Senior Year)

- \Box Double-check application details and essays
- □ Pay application fees (or request fee waivers)
- □ Submit applications before deadlines
- □ Save confirmation emails and receipts

🟅 7. After Submitting Applications (January – May, Senior Year)

- \Box Check email for application status updates
- □ Send mid-year grade reports (if required)
- □ Prepare for college interviews (if applicable)
- *f* Some colleges offer **optional interviews**—use them to showcase your personality and interest!

 \Box Write thank-you notes to recommenders

 $\hfill\square$ Wait for admission decisions and review acceptance letters
